The folks who sell furniture and home accessories order their new shipments in January and February. Then they have to make room for them. Ergo, clearance sales.

Through Feb. 18 at **Santa Fe Market**, 6651 S. University Blvd., Centennial, 303-781-1702, Navajo pottery, Zapotec rugs, life-size cast-aluminum animal sculptures and other Southwestern and American Indian goods are reduced by 20 percent to 50 percent.

The clearance runs through Feb. 23 at **Modern Bungalow**, 2594 S. Colorado Blvd., 303-300-3332, modernbungalow.com. You'll find deep discounts on discontinued and floor-sample lamps, ceiling fixtures, tables, bookcases, plant stands and light fixtures.

Boulder-based interior design and home-furnishings retailer **HW Home**, hwhome.com, has taken over the Lord & Taylor space at Flatiron Crossing for its annual warehouse sale, 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. today and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday. Floor samples, discontinued items and other clearance items from the company's stores in Cherry

Creek North, Broomfield and Boulder are reduced by 30 percent to 75 percent. For example, a Peyton sofa, originally \$3,995, is \$1,895.

With the Valentine sales, winter clearances and store closings, this is also a great time of year to buy clothing.

Selected sleepwear and lingerie is reduced by 20 percent through Valentine's Day at **Le Soutien**, 246 Milwaukee St., 303-377-0515.

At **Bolderdash**, 2721 E. Third Ave., 303-399-3940, skirts from Chaudry, Salaam

and others, originally \$92 to \$102, are \$55. Calvin Klein suits, regularly \$428, are \$269, and men's spring shirts, originally \$78 to \$98, are \$50. Discounts will increase until the store's last day, Feb. 28.

Tailored Angel women's apparel store, 303-519-9654 or 303-870-1613, was forced to vacate earlier than expected, so its store-closing sale has been rescheduled for 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. today at 2430 Lynx Place in the Vista Ridge development in Erie, near Interstate 25 and Colorado 7. In addition to clothing from Brazil Roxx, Seandara, Picadilly and others, displays and other fixtures also are deeply discounted.

During the winter clearance through February at **Susie's Ample Boutique**, 3890 Kipling St., Wheat Ridge, 303-420-0067, women's plus-size clothing from Personal Touch, Ulla Popken and Pegasus is reduced by 30 percent to 75 percent.
